- a. Welcome Morristown-Hamblen to the study group.
- b. LTFU rates continue to look good, with our region above the VQI national average. Topperforming centers have access to outpatient medical records and clinic notes, strong abstraction teams, and good communication with Vascular Surgery offices.
- c. Discharge medications rate = VQI overall rate. Success attributed to thorough discharge summaries, compliance with discharge pathways and protocols.
- d. Pre-operative Smoking is highest in nation. Smoking Cessation is below national average, but is historically a difficult metric to improve due. Possibly influenced by the way the metric is reported, will likely be reviewed in the upcoming Data Integrity Audits.
- e. Shwon improvement in EVAR Sac Diameter. Adding measurement to office note increases success of metric, as it is not always documented on Radiology report.
- f. OAAA Cell-Saver our best performance in past four years.
