<p>Group Discussion Long-Term Follow-Up: Karin</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Carrie sent the LTFU card out to the regional leaders as well as posted it on the national website for easy downloading and/or branding by each institution as a part of their LTFU toolkits. More information regarding the LTFU care card will follow in the March/April newsletter. • Physicians receive credit for LTFU care whether it is a phone call or face-to-face visit, as long as it is documented in the EHR. • Lead data manager meeting is March 17th. • Suggestions for possible regional group quality/research projects included data completion and long term follow up. Diane would like to see more work being done with LTFU cards for patients to carry in their wallets/on their person (similar to medical alert bracelets). • The group discussed the possibility of a Survey Monkey group abstraction project.

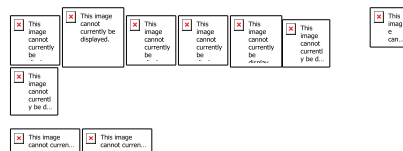
